

OTR Safety Rules

The safety of all employees, contractors, vendors, and truck drivers is of the upmost importance at Yusen Terminals. Please review the following safety rules:

- 1. Obey all posted speed limit, traffic signals, and signs.
- 2. Drivers must wear a high visibility/reflective safety vest and safety (steel toe) shoes while on the terminal.
- 3. Stop at all stop signs.
- 4. Obey all instructions from YTI Management and Security team.
- 5. Cellular phones not allowed while driving in the terminal or while being serviced.
- 6. Seat belts must be always worn while driving on the terminal.
- 7. Drivers must not approach operating equipment under any circumstances!
- 8. No lane hopping while entering or exiting the terminal.
- 9. Do not cut through delivery rows.
- 10. Do not attempt to do repair work on truck or equipment while in the terminal.
- 11. Only one driver will be allowed in a tractor while on the terminal, no riders/passengers allowed, unless pre-approved for training purposes by the Yusen Security department. (To arrange for a passenger ride-a-long training visit, please email: <u>ytismgr@yti.com</u>.)
- 12. Drivers must always remain in their tractors, unless:
 - a. Locking or unlocking chassis pins (in the designated in and out gate areas)
 - b. Hooking or unhooking a load or chassis,
 - c. Resolving a trouble ticket at Trouble Resolution
- 13. Hook up / connect both airlines on all chassis/containers.
- 14. Drivers are not to be under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or consume them while on terminal premises.
- 15. Watch for pedestrians, yard equipment, and other vehicles.
- 16. Yard equipment has the right of way.
- 17. Do not try to pass behind yard equipment that is backing up.
- 18. Stay back at least one container length when Top-pick/Side-pick is in a stacking row retrieving your container.
- 19. Refrain from fighting, horseplay, or distracting fellow workers or truck drivers
- 20. Know evacuation plans, this includes designated gathering areas and emergency escape routes. (Evacuation maps are in the Safety section of the website)

- 21. Do not leave your truck running if not attended and set brakes before exiting the vehicle.
- 22. Firearms are not permitted on terminal premises.
- 23. Drivers are never to drive or walk under a suspended load.
- 24. Lock and unlock chassis in designated areas, which are at the IN GATE and the OUT GATE only.

Yusen Terminals will cite and ban drivers that fail to follow Yusen Terminals safety rules. This is for the safety of the drivers as well as all others that work on the facility.
