We ensure operational commitment through stringent reviews of the manager's safety performance, comprehensive HSSE audits, and focus on actions to eliminate high-risk activities.

We will ensure that our operations meet the highest quality standards by promoting continuous improvement and full compliance with all HSSE laws and regulations.

We ensure that HSSE protection commands equal prominence with other business considerations in the decision-making process.


We partner with labor unions, federal and state agencies, and stakeholders to improve safety culture and performance.
